
1 Saw a Solar Eclipse

Thinking and discussion:

A solar Eclipse happens when the moon blocks our view of the sun. A partial eclipse can only be seen when viewed with solar viewing glasses or with a poke-hole projector. A total eclipse happens when the moon blocks out the entire sun from our view. You can only see a total eclipse if you are in what is called the path of totality. In the path of totality, when the moon casts its shadow, the stars and moon are visible as if it were night, but just for a few minutes.
