Step 1: Draw a diagonal line across each of the tiles.


Step 2: Color half of each tile. It does not matter which half you color.

Step 3: Cut out your tiles and arrange them to create your pattern! Then use a glue stick to paste your tiles to your mosaic.






Simple tiles can be used to make beautiful patterns.








My Mosaic
